Long made the motion to approve the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year End Bills to be Paid, Hayes seconded. Council voting Yes: Long, Cox, Misner, Snyder, Hayden and Hayes. No: None.

Mayor Conlin requested approval for reimbursements to the General Fund from the Telephone Utility Tax Fund for trees and signs purchased in fiscal year 2024-2025.
